First Phase - Steps for landowners to follow in filing a lease, variation of lease at etc.

- 1. Get a proposal plan or a final lease diagram at a Private Surveyor or Ministry of Justice (MOJ)
- 2. Uplift updated Register of Title or list of landowners of the said land from the MOJ
- 3. Identify area if it's under occupation right or not; if it is, require court order and consent from the occupier(s), if occupier deceased require death certificate for confirmation
 - 1. Copy of document can be uplifted from MOJ
- 4. See a lawyer, land agent and counsel to prepare document for lease
- 5. File application for MOAO (meeting of assembled owners) at MOJ

MOAO application fee @\$100

Second Phase - Steps for court staff to follow through for a MOAO

- 6. MOAO application check and received (document required: application signed and dated, updated register of title, lease diagram, occupation right court order, draft deed of lease);
- 7. Advise applicant from the date receiving of the application, there's a month wait for a landowners meeting to be set;
- 8. Give a running number and advise any available JP to direct meeting;
- 9. Once meeting is directed;
- 10. Set a date for a landowners meeting;
- 11. Notice issued out to applicant to distribute to landowners;
- 12. Explain notice and proxies to the applicant;
